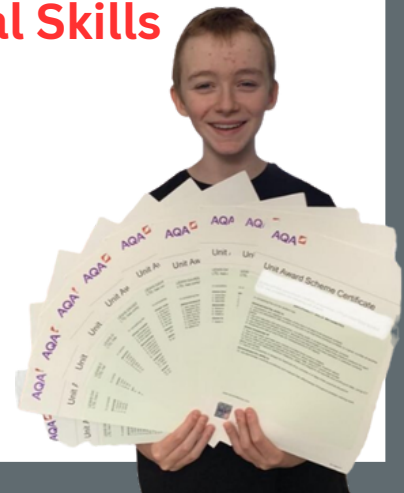



INTRODUCTION

This proposal outlines the implementation of LCB Education:

- for schools with SEND learners or those needing temporary provision during periods of exclusion
- as an alternative provision for learners with EOTAS packages or
- for those in need of an individualised provision in their EHCP .

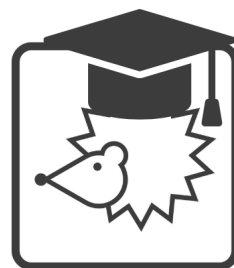
IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

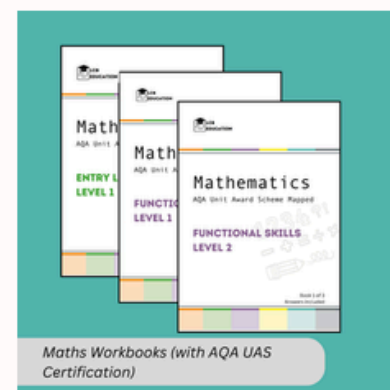
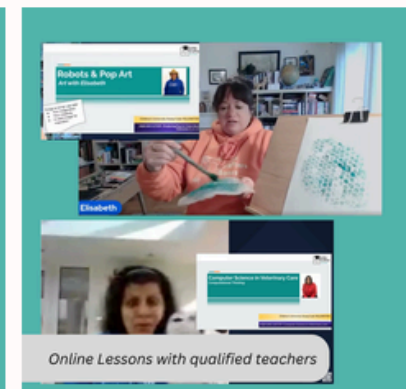
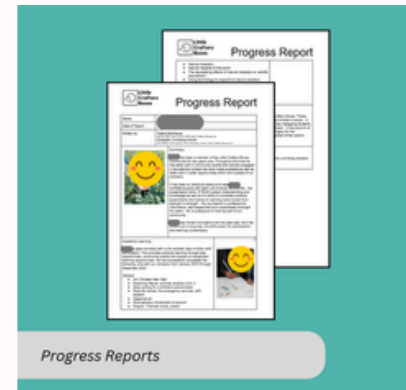
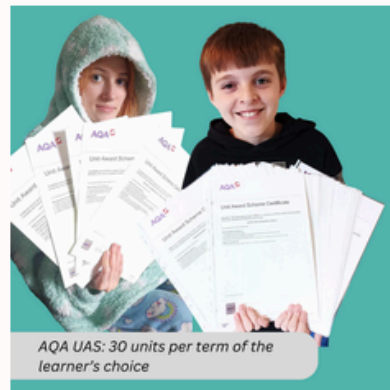
There is evidence that implementing the LCB Education programme of learning can significantly improve the educational outcomes for students and provide them with a positive and rewarding learning experience.

The COMPLETE Education Package incorporates English, Maths, and S.T.E.A.M subjects to form a well rounded curriculum.

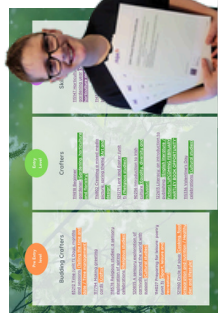
Typically EOTAS style packages are purchased with all services added, ready to go, but packages can be personalised and tailored to the learners needs or budget if needed.

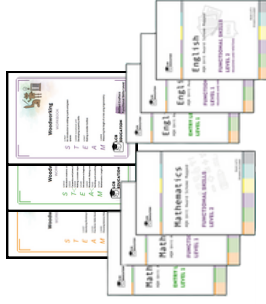

What is the Unit Award Scheme (UAS)?

UAS allows all students to engage with learning and have their achievements formally recognised.

Students are rewarded with a certificate each time they successfully complete a unit of learning. They can build up a portfolio of certificates to evidence their skills, knowledge and experience.

The scheme boosts confidence, increases engagement and improves motivation, helping students to make progress on their lifelong learning journey.

EOTAS stands for Educated Other Than At School. It is when the LA is responsible for funding all the EHCP needs of the child and finding an alternative provision for them.

What is the different between EOTAS and EHE?

One of the main differences is that with EOTAS learners the LA is responsible for funding and with EHE learners the responsibility lies with the parent. Not all EHE children have EHCP, EOTAS children do.

What if we don't need a full year? e.g. Section 19

Plans run in termly periods. You can purchase services for a single term if preferred .

As soon as registered. Unless you tell us you want to delay start, we will send out materials straight away.
