Identification Declaration Form


Identification Declaration Form

In the instance that the apprentice cannot provide a photo or scan of one of the three listed acceptable forms of identification (i.e. a valid passport, driver's licence or a staff photo ID card showing the apprentice's full name), we will accept a passport quality photograph of the Apprentice, alongside a signed declaration from the Employer.

The photo or scan must be clear - avoid poor lighting, shadowing or reflections.

The declaration must include the Apprentice's name and photo and state the following: "I can confirm that the photograph provided is a true likeness of the named Apprentice."

This should then be followed with the employer's name, signature and date, which must also be clearly recorded. An example is below.
