Feeding habits and suitable food sources for newly emerged moths (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Suitable conditions for releasing moths outdoors (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Observing caterpillar and moth behaviour in an indoor habitat using sketches and/or photographs (student completed work and/or photographs)
Evaluate the process of caring for moths including problems that can arise and possible solutions (student completed work).
