Outcomes

Recognise at least two different species of birds, eg Pigeon, Robin (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Name at least two different parts of a bird's body, eg beak, wing and describe how they use them in communication (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Describe how birds use birdsong to communicate (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Describe how birds use body language to communicate (summary sheet and/or student completed work)
Create artwork to show understanding of bird communication (student completed work and/or photographs)

Designing and making a model of a pet

Outcomes

Name, verbally or in writing, at least three different types of domestic pets (summary sheet)
Select one type of pet and investigate it, eg by collecting pictures or facts (student completed work)
Draw a design to make a model of the chosen type of pet (student completed work)
Select materials to construct the design, eg 'scrap materials', construction kit (summary sheet)
Construct the designed model of a pet with adult support if necessary (student completed work and/or photographs)
Taking part in a group discussion to evaluate their own work (summary sheet).
